I. Introduction

Since 2008, Kammersängerin Elīna Garanča has been thrilling her audience with the open-air concert “Klassik unter Sternen”, which took place at Stift Göttweig for many years and, since 2026, has found a new home in the unique setting of Grafenegg. This musical summer highlight was complemented in 2013 by “Klassik in den Alpen” in Kitzbühel, which quickly became another fixture in the local cultural landscape. Both concerts continue to embody the idea of making classical music of the highest standard accessible to a wide audience and are also the origin of the competition for young talents, “ZukunftsStimmen”.

Year after year, Elīna Garanča and Karel Mark Chichon invite great talents from the world of opera, such as Jonathan Tetelman, Valentina Naforiță, Bryan Hymel, Angel Joy Blue and Nadine Sierra, to perform with them at the “Klassik Open Air” concerts in Austria. This collaboration has often led to important career steps for the guests on the international opera stage.

Following on from this fact, the idea was born together with Elīna Garanča and Karel Mark Chichon to implement their own young talent initiative in the Austrian classical music sector as part of the “Klassik Open Air” concerts. The winner will have the opportunity to be in the spotlight together with Kammersängerin Elīna Garanča and Maestro Karel Mark Chichon at “Klassik unter Sternen” in Grafenegg (July 4, 2026) and take the next step in their career with the support of Raiffeisen.

In 2019, it was the 22-year-old newcomer **Alexander Grassauer**, in 2021 the 23-year-old **Philipp Schöllhorn** and in 2022 the 24-year-old **Marie-Sophie Janke**. In 2023, the young bass **Felix Pacher** won over the jury and the 5th edition was won by baritone **Clemens Alexander Frank**.

In the course of the reorientation of the competition in 2025, the young Slovenian soprano **Maja Triler** won the competition.

In addition to the performance at “Klassik unter Sternen”, the prize includes personal coaching with Kammersängerin Elīna Garanča and attractive prize money. Further attractive performance opportunities have already been created in previous years for the best-placed ZukunftsStimmen. This gives the audience the opportunity to get to know even more of the talented young singers.

Subject: Singing / all voice parts
Gender: male / female / diverse
Age: 18–32 years (birthday until March 1, 1993)
Other: Austrian citizenship
OR
studies (ongoing or completed) at an
Austrian university / conservatory



5. Prizes

FIRST PLACE

- Joint performance with Kammersängerin Elīna Garanča and Maestro Karel Mark Chichon as part of the “Klassik unter Sternen” concert in Grafenegg
- Prize money: EUR 11.500,— gross
(including the obligatory concert performances in Grafenegg)

SECOND PLACE

Prize money: EUR 3.500,— gross
(including the performance at the *Prélude* in the course of *Klassik unter Sternen*)

THIRD PLACE

Prize money: EUR 2.000,— gross
(including the performance at the *Prélude* in the course of *Klassik unter Sternen*)

6. Applications

a. Application period

Complete applications can be submitted in the period from November 18, 2025 to March 1, 2026.

Applications can only be submitted via the website

b. Application

The application documents *must* include:

- Proof of Austrian citizenship (e.g. a copy of the passport) OR proof of studies (ongoing or completed) at an Austrian university or conservatory
- Full contact details incl. copy of passport
- Sound document: Audio (mp3) or Video file (mp4, mov, avi) or a Youtube video link.
- Artist resume
- Portrait photography in high resolution in jpg format, black and white or color, with copyright information
- Edits or other technical manipulations of pitches or lengths within completed sentences are not permitted

c. Repertoire and competition program

In the first step, 3 arias from the classical opera and operetta repertoire are required. Piano accompaniment and amateur recordings are possible.

d. Admission

The jury's decision on admission to the competition will be communicated after selection at the mid of March 2026. The decisions are incontestable, no explanations will be given. The admitted candidates will receive a written confirmation.

e. Recognition of conditions

By registering for the competition, the participant accepts the conditions of participation and competition terms and conditions as well as the jury's decision as binding. Legal recourse is excluded.

Applications that do not meet the requirements of the competition may be rejected. Submitted documents and recordings cannot be returned.



7. Realization of the competition

a. Competition rounds

Several rounds are planned as part of the competition:

- Application phase: November 18, 2025 to March 1, 2026
- Preselection by the mid of March 2026
- Auditions: March 19, 2026

b. Dates

The following dates must be kept free by the participants (without exception):

- Press event in Vienna: April 28, 2026 (1st–3rd place)
- Rehearsals for the concerts: June 30 and July 1, 2026 (1st place)
- Performance at “Kulturpicknick mit Elīna Garanča ZukunftsStimmen” in Grafenegg: July 2, 2026 (1st–5th place)
- Performance at the public rehearsal: July 3, 2026 (1st place)
- Performance at “Klassik unter Sternen”: July 4, 2026 (1st place)
- Performance at the Prélude before “Klassik unter Sternen”: July 4, 2026 (2nd and 3rd place)

c. Audition

The audition will take place in Vienna (March 19, 2026). Those participants who are admitted to the audition will be given all further information in good time. All other participants will receive a written rejection letter.

d. Schedule

The participants selected by the jury will be sent the detailed competition documents and the repertoire.
